## Day 1: Saturday Oct 2 (D)

## Arrive in Bergen

Welcome to Norway!

On arrival at Bergen International Airport, you will be met by a local representative and transferred to our hotel by private vehicle. Check-in is available from 3:00pm. The rest of the day is at your leisure.

Tonight, **Welcome Dinner** at the hotel or at a local restaurant within walking distance.

**Accommodation:** Clarion Admiral Hotel Bergen, Standard Room, 2 nights (or similar)

## Day 2: Sunday Oct 3 (B)

## Bergen

Breakfast at the hotel.

Then, meet our private guide and driver at the hotel and departure for a **Private Bergen City Walking Tour (3 hours)**.

This walking tour of Bergen covers key historical and cultural landmarks, offering a comprehensive view of the city's charm. We will start with a visit to Bryggen Wharf, the UNESCO World Heritage Site known for its colorful wooden buildings. Here, we will explore the narrow wooden alleyways behind Bryggen, getting a deeper sense of

the city's history and architecture. Next, we will stop at Bergenhus Fortress, where we'll learn about Hakon's Hall, a royal residence from the 13th century, and the Rosenkrantz Tower, both representing Bergen's medieval and military history. After that, we will continue our way to Bergen Fish Market, where we may even get a chance to taste some local seafood while learning about the city's maritime significance. Then, we will visit St. Mary's Church, Bergen's oldest building dating to the 12th century, and learn about its Romanesque architecture and importance during the Hanseatic period. Continuing the tour, we pass through Torgallmenningen, the central square, where we will hear about modern-day Bergen and its urban development. This vibrant part of the city showcases a mix of shops, cafes, and the heart of Bergen's social life. At the end of the tour, we enjoy a quick ride up the Floibanen Funicular to Mount Floyen for panoramic views of the city, offering a great opportunity to take in the surrounding fjords and mountains.

After the tour, the remainder of the day is at leisure.

### **Day 3: Monday Oct 4      Bergen – Myrdal – Flam – Aurland/Gudvangen (B/D)**

After Breakfast at the hotel, we will meet with our private guide and transfer to the railway station.

*Note: Please prepare and bring your luggage to the reception by 8:00am this morning. It will be delivered to our hotel in Aurland/Gudvangen area. One piece of luggage per person is included.*

The adventure begins with a **scenic train ride from Bergen to Myrdal**, a mountain station on the famous Bergen Railway. Upon arrival in Myrdal, take the world-renowned Flåm Railway, one of the steepest and most picturesque train routes in the world, descending into the lush Flåm Valley.

After lunch in Flam (not included, own account), the journey continues with a **Fjord cruise through the Aurlandsfjord and Nærøyfjord**, both part of the UNESCO-listed West Norwegian Fjords, showcasing towering cliffs, cascading waterfalls, and serene Nordic beauty.

After the cruise, we will be picked up by our private driver and transferred to our hotel in the Aurland/Gudvangen area.

**Dinner** at the hotel and overnight

**Accommodation:** Aurland Fjordhotel, Standard Room, 1 night (or similar)

**Day 4: Tuesday Oct 5                      Aurland – Geiranger**  
**(B/D)**

Breakfast at the hotel.

Then, with our private guide and driver, we will leave the Aurland region and depart for **Geiranger**.

Depart from Aurland and journey through some of Norway's most spectacular autumn landscapes, with mountain roads, waterfalls, and fjord views along the way. Travel via Hellesylt and board a scenic ferry cruise into the UNESCO-listed **Geirangerfjord**, one of Norway's most dramatic fjords. Admire towering cliffs, cascading waterfalls such as the Seven Sisters, and colorful October scenery reflected in the calm waters. Arrive in Geiranger surrounded by breathtaking mountain peaks and fjord panoramas.

Upon arrival, check into your hotel and enjoy some free time.

**Dinner** at the hotel and overnight

**Accommodation:** Geiranger Avila Hotel, Standard Room, 2 nights (or similar)

**Day 5: Wednesday Oct 6                      Geiranger**  
**(B)**

Breakfast at the hotel.

Then, with our private guide and driver, we will depart for a **Private Full Day Tour of the Geirangerfjord area**.

Discover the breathtaking landscapes surrounding Geiranger on a full-day scenic exploration of one of Norway's most spectacular fjord regions. Travel along the famous Eagle Road, a dramatic mountain route offering incredible views over the winding Geirangerfjord and surrounding peaks. Continue to the iconic Dalsnibba Viewpoint (weather access permitting), with panoramic vistas over the fjord far below. Along the way, stop at scenic overlooks and hidden viewpoints to capture the waterfalls, rugged mountains, and autumn colors of the region.

After the tour, we return to our hotel in Geiranger. The evening is at your leisure.

**Day 6: Thursday Oct 7** **Geiranger - Alesund**  
**(B)**

Breakfast at the hotel.

Then, again with our private guide and driver, we will leave Geiranger and **travel to Alesund.**

Today, we will be travelling through the spectacular fjord landscapes of the Sunnmøre region. Depart Geiranger and follow the beautiful mountain roads with stops at panoramic viewpoints overlooking the fjords, including opportunities to admire the dramatic scenery around Eidsdal and the Norddalsfjord area. Continue through charming villages such as Valldal, known for its fertile valley, strawberry farms, and stunning mountain surroundings, before following the scenic coastal route toward the fjord communities of Stordal and Sjøholt. Along the way, enjoy photo stops at beautiful fjord viewpoints, peaceful villages, and landscapes where mountains meet the sea.

Continue toward Ålesund, a charming city famous for its elegant Art Nouveau architecture and spectacular waterfront setting. Upon arrival, enjoy a brief city tour (approximately 2 hours), discovering highlights such as the historic center, colorful streets, and harbor views, followed by free time to explore independently or perhaps visiting local cafés, boutiques, the waterfront, or the viewpoint at Aksla Viewpoint for one of Norway's most memorable city panoramas.

Then, check into our hotel and enjoy the evening at your leisure.

**Accommodation:** Scandic Parken Hotel, Standard Room, 2 nights (or similar)

**Day 7: Friday Oct 8** **Alesund**  
**(B)**

After Breakfast, enjoy the day at your leisure in Alesund.

**Day 8: Saturday Oct 9** **Alesund – Atlantic Ocean Road –**  
**Kristiansund (B/D)**

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out.

Then, we will leave Alesund and **travel to Kristiansund via the Atlantic Ocean Road.**

Today, we will experience one of Norway's most spectacular coastal journeys from Ålesund to Kristiansund, travelling through the breathtaking landscapes of the Nordmøre coastline. Depart Ålesund and follow scenic fjord roads through charming coastal communities and small villages, with opportunities to admire dramatic mountain views, islands, and traditional fishing settlements along the way.

Continue toward Molde, known as the "City of Roses," where we can enjoy views across the fjord toward the famous Romsdal Alps. From here, we will travel along the coastal route through villages such as Eide before reaching one of Norway's most iconic engineering marvels — the Atlantic Ocean Road. This dramatic 8-kilometre route connects a series of small islands and skerries with sweeping bridges, including the famous Storseisundet Bridge, offering unforgettable views of the open Atlantic Ocean.

Enjoy stops along the route to experience the rugged coastline, sea spray, fishing heritage, and panoramic viewpoints. Continue onward through coastal villages and island landscapes before arriving in Kristiansund, picturesque harbor city spread across several islands and historically known for its clip fish (dried cod) production. Upon arrival, enjoy time to explore the waterfront, colorful harbor area, and charming streets of this unique coastal town.

Then, check into our hotel for **dinner** and overnight.

**Accommodation:** Thon Kristiansund Hotel, Standard Room, 1 night (or similar)

## Day 9: Sunday Oct 10      Kristiansund – Trondheim (B/D)

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out.

**Depart Kristiansund to Trondheim** and follow scenic roads through fjords, islands, and peaceful countryside, passing charming villages and coastal communities that showcase the region's maritime heritage. Continue through areas such as Aure and along the scenic routes of Trøndelag, with opportunities for stops overlooking fjords, mountains, and traditional Norwegian landscapes.

Arrive in Trondheim, the original capital of Norway, also known as Nidaros until the 16<sup>th</sup> century. With our private guide, we departure for a **walking tour of Trondheim** including visit to the magnificent Nidaros Cathedral, Norway's national sanctuary and a masterpiece of Gothic

architecture built over the burial site of Olav the Holy. Continue to visit the old harbour area of Bakklandet with its cozy and colourful row of piers and wooden houses. Stroll through the main passing by the royal residence of Siftsgarden and take in the sights as we learn about the history and culture of this fantastic city.

After the tour, check into our hotel for **dinner** and overnight.

**Accommodation:** Clarion Hotel Trondheim, Standard Room, 2 nights (or similar)

### Day 10: Monday Oct 11                      Trondheim (B/L)

Breakfast at the hotel. Then, with our guide, we departure for a **visit of Trondheimsfjord with walk along the fjord (3 hours)**.

Enjoy a relaxing excursion from Trondheim to experience the beauty and tranquility of the surrounding Trondheimsfjord, one of Norway's largest and most scenic fjords. Travel through the peaceful countryside surrounding the fjord, passing charming villages, farmland, and coastal landscapes that reflect the region's rich maritime traditions.

Arrive at a scenic fjord area for a leisurely walk along the shoreline, following beautiful coastal paths with panoramic views over the water, surrounding mountains, and islands. Enjoy the fresh Nordic air, changing autumn colors, and the peaceful atmosphere of the fjord. The walk is designed to highlight the natural beauty and slower pace of life along the Trondheimsfjord.

Then, relax and enjoy **lunch at a local restaurant**.

After lunch, return to our hotel in Trondheim. The remainder of the day is at your leisure.

### Day 11: Tuesday Oct 12                      Trondheim / Oslo (B/D)

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out.

Then, we will be transferred to Trondheim airport to take a domestic flight to Oslo. *Flight included*.

Upon arrival in Oslo, we meet our private guide and driver and depart for a **Tour of Oslo (3 hours)**.

Our guide will take us through Oslo and show us its contrasts through hundreds of years of construction. The capital has drawn

attention as a city of modern architecture and design, and the tour starts at the new Opera house in Bjorvika. We will see the famous sights of the city - Oslo Cathedral (Oslo Domkirke), the Royal Castle, the new Opera House, the university, the City Hall and Parliament Building and other old historical buildings. We will visit Vigeland Sculpture Park, which is home to a vast collection of sculptures which inhabit its landscape. The park portrays Gustave Vigeland's observation of the themes of life and relationships. Vigelandsparken, also known as Frognerparken, is one of the most popular places to meet for people living in Oslo.

After the tour, check into your hotel (available from 3:00pm) and enjoy some free time.

Tonight, **Farewell Dinner at a local restaurant** in Oslo.

**Accommodation:** Clarion The Hub Hotel, Standard Room, 1 night (or similar)

## **Day 12: Wednesday Oct 13 Oslo - Departure (B)**

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out.

According to your flight schedule, you will have a private transfer to Oslo Airport to take your flight back home. *Flight not included.*
